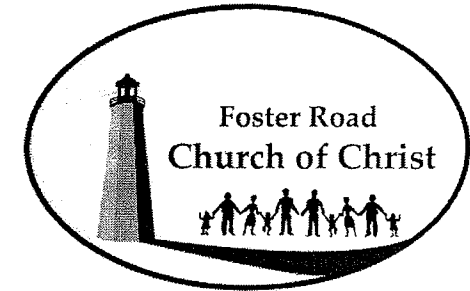

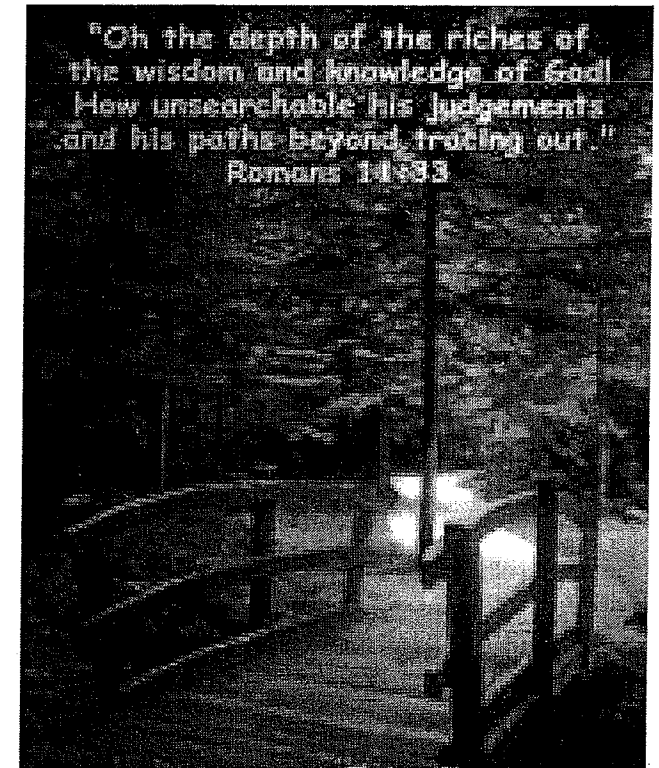

Tell Your Story

Scripture Thought:

"...Whether it is right in the sight of God to give heed to you rather than to God, you be the judge; for we cannot stop speaking what we have seen and heard" (Acts 4:19-20).

In 1985 she and her husband traveled to the Philippines to work as missionaries. This husband and wife wanted to have a baby boy, so they prayed diligently for "Timmy" and eventually she became pregnant.

Unfortunately Pam went into a coma from contracting an infection of the intestine cause by a parasite found in contaminated food or drink. The disease called for very strong medication that had a very high risk of causing irreversible damage to Tim – so they advised an abortion. Pam said no. She cited her strong faith in God as the reason for her hope that Tim would be born without any devastating disabilities. In August 1987, a Heisman Trophy winner was born.

In 2007 Tim Tebow became the first sophomore in the history of the NCAA to win this highly prized trophy and be recognized as the best football player in the nation. This would never have happened if Pam Tebow would have accepted the doctor's advice. This story will be told during the Super Bowl on February 7. John preserved a story of a man who had been born blind (John 9). The "leaders" of the Jewish faith tried to discount the significance of this miracle. Finally the blind man said, "... one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see".

I believe that everyone has a story to tell. It may not be as profound as the Tebow's, or this blind man, but it may be just the story that someone needs to hear.
