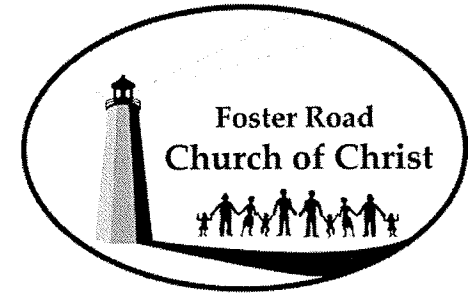

Happy Fathers Day

I tried to convince my grandchildren that Sunday (today) was grandfather's day. I was quickly informed that it was Father's Day. I looked at them with a sad face and the youngest one said, "Well, you're a dad." Isn't family wonderful? Here are four thoughts for effective fathering:

Patience: Exercise patience with your children. When one is patient, then a safe environment exists that give the children freedom to discover new things in this world. If we are not patient, then a hostile environment usually is created resulting in fear. When we do that then creativity is lost and their desire for new discoveries is squashed.

Provision: Take another look at Matthew 6:26. Even halfway responsible fathers want their children to be provided for. One of the basic human needs is that of having provisions. There are the natural things, such as food, shelter and clothing; and there are the spiritual things such as spiritual food and spiritual growth. Sometimes these provisions are given in kindness and sometimes in mercy.

Protection: A home needs to be a safe haven. Fathers need to stand between their children and the world. Let your child feel safe talking to you about whatever

he/she needs to talk with you about. A home needs to be a place where dad stands between their child and the devil. Teach them to know the way of escape from temptation. Relate to them the times that you got out of temptation and the times we failed and what it cost.

Permanence: Children need to know their father is coming home after work. That dad will be there tuck them into bed, to tell them to put that cell phone away (turn it off), and to hear dad tell them to turn down the music. The need to know that their father is ready to forgive, to repent and will to sacrifice for the family.
